I would like to introduce myself to those of you who don't know me.

For the new members Nancy and I have been members of the Desert Roadrunners since 2005. I have held the position of 1st Vice President and President a couple of times and now I am your treasurer.

Zelle payment process:

I would like to implement some new payment processing procedures that will save you some money when sending rally fees, membership dues and submitting rally reservation & dues renewal forms. With the cost of postage stamps going sky high, I would like to encourage you to do the following if possible.

Rally fee

Zelle account: Desert Road Runners tresturtle@gmail.com.

At the May Chapter meeting at Patagonia, due to rising costs, it was voted to increase rally fees to \$15.00 per RV.

I have set up Zelle with the chapter bank account and you can use Zelle to transfer the \$15.00 rally fee to our Desert Roadrunners account at Desert Road Runners tresturtle@gmail.com. You have to have a cell phone in order to use Zelle. If you do not have a Zelle account, download the app from either the Apple Store for iPhone or the Play Store for Android phones.

I have conducted extensive research and Zelle is safe and is recognized by most banks as a safe way to transfer money.

Rally reservation form: Sent monthly in email, also posted on our website under home >News > Newsletter. If you do not have the capabilities of the program PDF, which would allow you to fill out the form on your computer or cell phone, then I recommend that you manually fill out the form, scan or take a picture of it and attach it to an email and send it to me at tresturtle@gmail.com.

If you can fill out the form with a PDF program, then email the completed form to me.

If you cannot do either of the above, mail it to me at Terry Whaley, 2096 Golf Links Road, Sierra Vista, AZ 85635.

Expense report: Posted on our website under Home >Forms > Expense Report.

The same procedures as outlined above apply to the Expense Report. If you have a Zelle account, request a Zelle reimbursement. I will send your reimbursement via Zelle.

If you do not have a Zelle account, manually fill out the form, scan or take a picture of it and attach it to an email and send it to me at tresturtle@gmail.com.

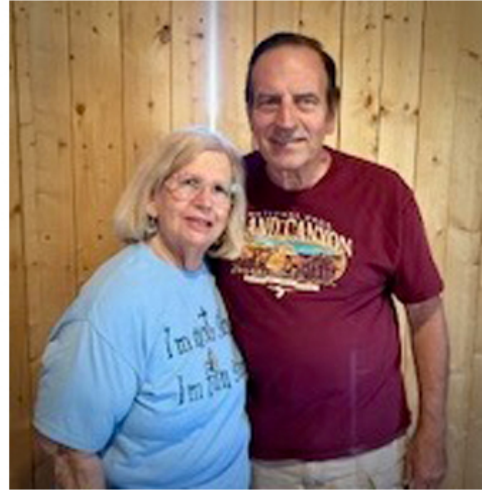
