Besides a review of past minutes and current treasury, members had an opportunity to approve a new set of ByLaws along with a Proposed Rally Schedule for the 2025-2026 Rally Year.

Desert Roadrunner Chapter Rules & Regulations

- 1. The Desert Roadrunners Chapter is an affiliate Chapter of RMMA (Rocky Mountain Motorhome Association) and FRVA (Family RV Association) formally FMCA (Family Motor Coach Association)
- 2. Desert Roadrunners members must be and remain members in good standing of FRVA.
- 3. Desert Roadrunners organizational rally year is September 1 through May 31 of the following year.
- 4. The Nominating Committee Chairman is elected by the membership in January at or after the annual meeting.
- 5. Election of officers is held in May in election years.
- 6. Desert Roadrunners elected Governing Board of officers' term of office is for 2 years; June 1 to May 31 for 2 years.
- 7. Chapter meetings are held as deemed necessary during Chapter functions by the President or Executive Board.
- 8. The Chapter will conduct a 50/50 Drawing at Chapter meetings with 50% of the monies going to worthy causes determined by those in attendance.
- 9. The Chapter Annual dues will be Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per year.

Dues are due September 1st of each year. A late fee of \$10.00 is assessed after December 1.

Members who are two (2) months in arrears will be dropped from the active Chapter roster.

- 10. The Chapter rally schedule will be presented and approved by the membership at the January annual luncheon.
- 11. Desert Roadrunners rally fees are \$15.00 per coach. Additional rally fees may be assessed to cover the costs of rallies.
- 12. The Chapter official name tag will be worn from the first day through the last day of each rally.
- 13. Guests are welcome and encouraged to attend Chapter functions. Sponsors of guests are expected to ensure fees associated with the function are paid. After two visits guests are expected to join the Chapter.
- 14. Quiet Time: Members will observe quite time rules established by the RV Park.
- 15. Smoking or vaping is not allowed at any indoor or outdoor club functions.
- 16. Pets are not allowed at any indoor or outdoor club functions.
- 17. Members are expected to leave the RV park/facilities cleaner than they were found.
- 18. Desert Roadrunners Chapter will pay \$500.00 for the National Director to attend the FRVA Governing Board meetings. If the National Director is unable to attend, the funds will be paid to the Alternate National Director or elected delegate.

March Rally Update

YUMA RALLY UNDER CONSIDERATION: Thursday, March 6, 2025 - Monday, March 10, 2025

We voted last year & this year 2025-2026 to return to Desert Holiday RV Resort that offered Passport America (PA) 50% off and a Club House for our use for our March Wash & Wax & Car Show rally.

The Corporation, MARS Properties, that owns Desert Holiday RV Resort, only allows reservations to be made each January for the year. When Ed White, our VP – Rally's, called to confirm our March rally reservations, they informed him they no longer honor Passport America (PA) and they now have a additional \$15.00 registration fee. They also confirmed that once we arrive at the RV resort we could request use of the Club House.

Current Fees are \$50.00 a night (plus tax and a \$15.00 registration fee)

The Roadrunner Board is now taking the following options into consideration.

- 1. Pay the \$50.00 a night at Desert Holiday RV Resort but get a confirmation in writing we definitely have use the Club House during our rally: Thursday, March 6 Monday March 10.
- 2. Select another park that may or may not have a Club House for our use In contacting other YUMA PA Parks:
 - Most RV Parks do not offer PA discount in March
 - RV parks that offer PA:
 - · 1st 2 nights @ \$25.00 50% discount
 - additional nights \$50.00 no discount
 - Other RV parks only offer
 - 1 night 50% discount \$25.00
 - additional nights \$50.00
- 3. Cancel Yuma and go to another location that hopefully has a Club House and as a bonus we can have our RV's washed & waxed.

Ed is researching options. We need your input of what you, our Members want to do. if you have any ideas or suggestions, please get in touch with him.
