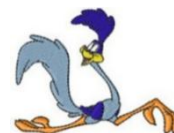

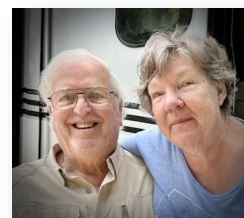

- **PET HEALTH & SHOT CERTIFICATE: ALWAYS PACK** current health & rabies shot certificates.

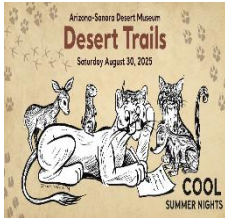
